Tips on Constructing Your Poster

Be consistent

- Keep consistent margins
- Keep line spacing consistent
- Keep color, style and thickness of borders the same
- Keep shading consistent

Limit text

- Put details in a handout
- Goal: 20% text, 40% graphics, 40% space

Make sure ideas flow from panel to panel logically (consider numbering panels)

Use Charts and graphs to illustrate data (avoid large tables of raw data)

Use high resolution photographs (Web images often won't work)

Pick 2-3 fonts

- Headings – Good Old Style, Bold, Shadowed, Garnet, Centered
- Body Text – Verdana, Black, Left Justified
- Labels – Arial, Black, Left Justified

Pick 2-3 colors

- Consider school or institutional colors
- Use the same principles for contrast that you might use for a PowerPoint presentation
- Conserve on ink by limiting solid color backgrounds by using white or light colors

Test readability

- Title banner should be able to be read from 20 ft
- Body text should be able to be read from 6 ft
- Suggested font sizes (will vary slightly depending on font style)
 - o Title of poster: 96-120 pt
 - o Author(s) and institution: 60-72 pt
 - o Headings: 60-72 pt
 - o Body Text: 32-48 pt
 - o Labels: 20-32 pt
- Do not use all capital letters
